FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What does the presentation consist of?

FOR GRADES K-2:

- **Core Message**
(15 Minutes): Presenters educate students on the importance of friendship, kindness and supporting one another.
- **Interactive Session**
(15 Minutes): Presentation creates an awareness of key emotions through an engaging activity that includes songs and stories
- **Closing**
(15 Minutes): Presentation closes by identifying the audience's support network in each other, as a school community. Presenters reiterate the importance of expressing difficult situations so no one is alone in how they feel.

FOR GRADES 3-5 AND 6-8:

- **Core Message**
(25 Minutes): Presenter shares personal, heartfelt stories to help connect with the audience. Issues like bullying, cliques, and homework as well as challenges like frequent moves, deployment, and reintegration are introduced.
- **Movie**
(25 Minutes): From Trevor Romain's Award winning PBS series, the animated clips talk to kids in their own language about the challenges introduced during the core message.
- **Interactive Session**
(25 Minutes): Led by the presenter, this integral part of the presentation allows children to express their feelings, fears and concerns in a safe environment.

What is the goal of the presentation?

The presentation will help kids learn to manage and express their feelings in a safe environment. We will discuss strategies to help children become Happier, Healthier, and More Confident.



What do the follow up resources include?

Shortly after the tour visits, the Comfort Crew for Military Kids will provide military kids at each school a FREE kit containing age appropriate materials courtesy of the USO.

- The Military Child Empowerment Pack is a kit designed with age appropriate materials. It contains six, full-length, episodes of Trevor Romain's award-winning animated PBS TV series, a journal for the child, and companion materials, for parents. Empowerment Packs are separated between grades 1-3 and 4-6.
- The Military Youth Resiliency Pack is a kit designed for kids grades 6-8. It contains a journal, With You All the Way! Poster, dogtags, With You All the Way! Pen and stylus and the companion family guidebook.



Who can attend the presentation?

- Presentations are broken up by grades K-2nd, 3-6th or 6-8th audiences
- Students, parents, teachers, counselors, administrators
- Civilian and military kids (only military kids receive follow up resources)



What does the school need to provide?

- White projector screen or blank wall space
- Electrical outlet
- School staff, including at least one counselor
- A space big enough for students to sit assembly style on the ground (i.e. Auditorium, Library, Gym, etc.)

2 The Movie (25 minutes)



Following the Core Message, students view an animated video developed with the input of their peers. TTRC will build on their knowledge gained to create the award-winning, PBS series and will extend information on these issues pertinent to military and non-military students, normalize the experiences growing up in a military family, and connect youth with each other through animated characters.

3 Interactive Session (25 minutes)



Led by Trevor, this integral part of the presentation allows youth to participate in a discussion and express their feelings, fears, and concerns in a safe environment. Trevor wraps up the presentation with positive messages of support and encouragement and reinforces the healthy coping strategies the students have learned.
